

Minutes of the PVCA Meeting – October 29, 2009

Attendance: 5

The meeting opened at 7:30 with President Steve Selinger presiding.

The meeting was called to order with Jenny Brown, Perri Strawn and Jeannie Cohen either sick or out of town.

Commissioner Taylor was on hand to present a recap of the Township Commissioners recent activities

1. There have been several burglaries in LMT – principally unlocked cars. residents are advised to lock cars – even in your own driveway.
2. A new solid waste fee structure was adopted by the Board.
A fee of \$200 will be assessed for rear yard collection.
\$254 will be charged for the first 45 gallon can.
\$50 will be charged for each additional can.
There will be an allowance for smaller cans.
3. An agreement has been reached with the FOP.
3.75% raise.
Increased FOP insurance contribution.
The exact dollar amount was not disclosed
4. The initial Township budget will be released on 11/6. Hearings will be held on 18th and subsequent.
5. Commissioner Taylor indicated that increases will be less than advertised, but said that the solid waste fee increase is not included in his calculations.
6. Commissioner Taylor also advised that the Civic should look to hold a special meeting concerning water runoff in the region.

Steve Selinger acknowledged that the public posting of the changes to the PVCA bylaws had not been posted and would be done before the November meeting.

With a World Series game pending, the meeting was adjourned at 7:55.
