1. Discussion of election of new PVCA officers for 2009-2010.
 - a. Nomination and election of Steve Selinger, long-time Penn Valley resident, as the next President. Steve discussed his desire to build up the PVCA and expand its impact.
 - b. Nomination and election of Jayson Glassman to the PVCA as Vice President of the Board, a new resident of Penn Valley who would like to be involved because of his interest in local issues.
 - c. Discussion of ways to get more people involved through various activities.
 - d. Discussion of the additional board positions that will be vacant in the next year.
2. Discussion of how the Civic can have more of an impact on the School Board and its issues.
3. Commissioner Taylor's report
 - a. Stop signs have been installed at the intersection of Broadacre and Braeburn.
 - b. The dog park at Rolling Hill is off to a good start, with more than 100 permits issued.
 - c. A project was approved to widen Belmont to Avenue to 4 lanes from the Schuykill expressway approximately to the cemetery. This plan also included a proposal to widen Rock Hill Road at both ends. Last year the funding from PennDOT was delayed till 2013. Commissioners are now seeking stimulus plan money to fund this project to see if it can get done sooner.
 - d. The township has purchased the Spaventa parcel and negotiations are underway to acquire 8 acres from the cemetery, to be a head to the Cynwyd trail and an off-leash dog park.
 - e. A farmer's market for Bryn Mawr has been approved for Saturdays for four hours from April to October starting this year.
 - f. Channel 99 can now be also viewed on Channel 34 for subscribers to Verizon's FIOS service.
 - g. No crime has occurred in Penn Valley recently except for automobile accidents.
 - h. The hockey rink at the back of the Belmont Hills swimming pool will be redone.
